He joined the Board after serving for over two years as Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). Prior to his tenure at OSHA, Mr. Visscher was Vice President of Employee Relations at the American Iron and Steel Institute. From 1999-2000, Mr. Visscher was a presidential appointee to the Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission, an independent body that adjudicates contested OSHA citations.
