



Deployment Activities

- Deployed October 12, 2024, and held opening meeting
- Conducted over 30 interviews
- Began evidence collection
- Ongoing Investigation

Incident Description

October 10, 2024, at approximately 4:30 p.m., a hydrogen sulfide release occurred at the PEMEX Deer Park facility's amine recovery unit while workers were attempting to remove an isolation blind from piping that normally transports hydrogen sulfide gas.

Incident Consequences

- 2 fatal injuries.
- 13 injured workers were transported to local medical facilities.
- PEMEX issued a site-wide shelter in place immediately following the incident
- A shelter-in-place order was given to two neighboring cities
- A portion of TX State Hwy 225 was temporarily closed
